Internationally renowned Family Therapist Maurizio Andolfi is presenting a two day workshop in Albany. His credentials are extensive and is the Professor of Psychology at La Sapienza-University of Rome, Director of the Accademia di Psicoterapia Familiare in Rome and Editor-in-Chief of the Italian family therapy journal: *Terapia Familiare*. Maurizio has worked extensively with disadvantaged families since 1970 with a myriad of ethnic groups and has conducted training and experiential practica with professionals from all over the world for the past 35 years. Workshop Outline – The two day workshop will be experiential and offers professionals the opportunity to explore the projection of therapists dealing with severely problematic individuals and families. The aim of this workshop is to support the therapist to work on her/his difficulties that might present when working with families and couples. Genograms, family sculptures and role-plays will be some of the concrete tools used to explore family myths and intergenerational cut-off as well as discovering family resilience and strength. Participants will learn how to use themselves more freely in therapy at different levels and learn how to stay close to the client/s' pain and despair.
